TYPE OF SCHOLARSHIP

Career/Technical Dual Enrollment – up to 2 Courses

CONDITIONS OF THE CONTRACT

1. All recipients must be enrolled as full-time students in an area high school. Scholarship will be terminated if student withdraws from high school.
2. Students are expected to use the scholarship money to earn a certification or degree in specific high wage, high demand career fields. Students who do not intend to use the scholarship for this purpose, will lose his/her scholarship opportunity.
3. Scholarship award may only be applied toward courses that satisfy a requirement for certification in the student's chosen career/technical program.
4. Students may withdraw from courses within the first week of class with no penalty (date TBD). Withdrawing from or failing to complete a course with a grade of "C" or better will result in termination of scholarship opportunity.
5. Scholarship recipients must maintain a semester GPA of 2.5 or above and a grade of C or higher in all attempted college courses. Failure to maintain the minimum grade requirement and who withdraw from a course will result in termination of scholarship and suspension from the program for a minimum of one term. One term suspension may not be served during the summer term. The student may not re-enroll until the suspension has been served. For re-entry, the student must reapply to the program and must meet the minimum unweighted grade point average. The scholarship is not available upon re-entry
6. Recipients must be students in good standing at all times.
7. Scholarship can be renewed for each semester in which student remains in high school as long as funds are available.
