The total number of graduates from the Wallace State Community College Occupational Therapy Assistant program during the 3-year period from 2013-2015 was 104, with a total graduation rate of 95%.

National Board for Certification in Occupational Therapy (NBCOT) Exam Results

Graduates of the Wallace State OTA program are eligible to sit for the National Certification Examination for the Occupational Therapy Assistant, administered by the National Board for Certification in Occupational Therapy (NBCOT). After successful completion of this exam, the graduate will be a Certified Occupational Therapy Assistant (COTA). In addition, most states require licensure to practice; however, state licenses are usually based on the results of the NBCOT Certification Exam. A felony conviction may affect a graduate's ability to sit for the NBCOT examination or attain state licensure.
