

**What is
Adult Education?**

Adult Education is a nonprofit program to assist individuals who have discontinued public education enrollment or whose high school class has graduated and who do not have a high school diploma. Adults who need to learn the English language. Individuals with or without a high school diploma needing basic skills development for employment purposes are also eligible.

Workkeys testing and preparation

One of the following items **MUST** be presented during Orientation:

- A valid, unexpired Alabama driver's license
- A valid, unexpired Alabama non-driver identification card
- A valid tribal enrollment card bearing a photograph or a biometric identifier
- Any valid United States federal or state government issued identification document bearing a photograph or other biometric identifier, if issued by an entity that requires proof of lawful presence in the United States before issuance
- A foreign passport with an unexpired United States VISA
- A foreign passport issued by a visa waiver county, or an I-94W form

WorkKeys Preparation and Certification

All Wallace State Adult Education Students have the opportunity to take the Workkeys Certification exam at NO COST.

The Workkeys Certification is a national workforce development system that permits a direct comparison of the skills and levels of skills needed to perform a job with the skills and levels of skills an individual currently posses. Classification exams are used by employers to validate career readiness skills.

The Workkeys Certification exam evaluates three areas of work skills:

Applied mathematics
Reading for Information
Locating Information
