We are excited to let you know about this year's Bio-Botics Institute that will be at Wallace State Community College in July. Bio-Botics Institute is the same event as the former Workforce Development STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics), just with a new name. We look forward to this event that should be both exciting and helpful in determining your career interests. The dates are as follows:

**Biotechnology Camp: July 7 – 10<sup>th</sup>**

**Robotics/Advanced Manufacturing Camp: July 6<sup>th</sup> – 9<sup>th</sup>**

Camps will start at 8 am and finish each day at 3 pm. You will need to provide your own transportation to and from Wallace State Community College each day. All transportation during the actual camps will be provided by Wallace State. To assist with fuel costs and incidental expenses during the camps, students who attend all four days will receive a \$100 stipend. Attendance at all sessions is **mandatory** to receive the stipend. Lunch and refreshments will be provided during all camp days. Please do not bring coolers or other refrigeration devices unless they serve prescribed and pre-certified medical necessities. Students will receive a Bio-Botics Institute completion certificate at the conclusion of the camps. Bio-Botics Institute is for students ages 16 +.

Please complete the enclosed *Bio-Botics Institute Application* indicating which camp you wish to participate. The enclosed forms **MUST BE COMPLETED AND SIGNED BOTH BY YOU AND YOUR LEGAL PARENTS/GUARDIANS.** If **ALL** forms are not completed, signed and returned to us prior to the camp start date, you **WILL NOT** be allowed to participate in the camp(s) for which you have applied. **Deadline for applications is: Friday, June 19, 2009.**
