

HIT Program Application Process

Have you attended WSCC?

- **Yes** - Change major to Pre-HIT.
- **No** - Apply for admission to WSCC (you will submit WSCC application, official high school and college transcripts, ACT scores, COMPASS test scores and obtain WSCC student ID).

Have you taken the ACT test?

- **Yes** - Submit official scores to WSCC (minimum composite score of 17 is required for HIT Program admission). If composite score is less than 17, you may retake the ACT test and have scores submitted to WSCC by June 15th.
- **No** - Take ACT test and have official scores reported to WSCC (minimum composite score of 17 is required for HIT program eligibility).

Have you taken the COMPASS reading test within 3 years?

- **Yes** - Submit Reading score of at least 76 as part of HIT Application Packet.
- **No** - Take COMPASS test (reading score of at least 76 is required for HIT Program eligibility. If score is less than 76 the COMPASS test can be retaken).

Complete HIT admission packet

- HIT Program Application
- Copy of ACT composite score of at least 17 (these may be on transcripts)
- Copy of COMPASS Reading score of at least 76 taken within past three years or if ACT taken within past three years, reading sub score of 17 on ACT
- Unofficial copy of college transcripts

By June 15th

- Submit HIT Application Packet to HIT Program Director. Note: Do not submit this packet to the WSCC Admission Office.
- Schedule interview by phone, email, or in person with HIT Program advisor.

Complete * all required prerequisite courses by end of summer semester of application

- ORI 101 or 103 (if applicable)
- MTH 116
- ENG 101 and 102
- BIO 201 and 202 (BIO 103 prerequisite)
- PSY 200
- CIS 146
- HUM

* If all courses except BIO 202 have been completed by the end of the summer semester of HIT Program application, BIO 202 may be completed in the fall of admission to program, but HIT 110 must be completed in the summer of program application before admission to the HIT Program.
