Admission Requirements for International Students

International student information and forms can be viewed on the Admissions page at www.wallacestate.edu.

Wallace State Community College accepts international students who have an F-1 visa and meet the academic, linguistic and financial requirements outlined below:

First Time College Students

---An international student who holds an American High School diploma or diploma from his/her country that is equivalent may be eligible for admission:

1. *A complete application in English.*
2. *Official transcripts in English that documents graduating from a secondary school that is equivalent to a U.S. high school and transcripts from all previously attended colleges or universities. Records must be mailed directly to Wallace State Community College from the institution attended. Personal copies are not accepted. Applicants must have the high school transcripts evaluated by Lisano International in order to determine admissions eligibility. For transfer credits from foreign colleges or universities to be considered, the college transcripts must also be evaluated by Lisano International.*

3. *Test of English as foreign language (TOEFL) requirements:*
 - *A minimum written score of 500 or,*
 - *A minimum computer-based score of 173 or,*
 - *A minimum internet-based score of 61*
 - *The scores must be mailed directly from the educational testing service to the Office of Admissions and Records. Personal copies are not accepted.*
 - *An IELTS band score of 5.5 or greater will also be accepted.*

EXCEPTIONS: (TOEFL)

- A. *A graduate of an accredited U.S. high school or completion of ENG 101 at an accredited college.*

4. *A signed notarized statement declaring that the international applicant will be fully responsible and that funds are available for financial obligations during enrollment with Wallace State Community College. Financial obligations include but are not limited to: tuition, fees, books, supplies, living expenses and housing. **A bank statement or letter (on bank letterhead) dated within six (6) months of the first day of class attendance must be attached.** Income tax statements, land holdings, salary declarations, proof of personal property, and computer printouts **are not acceptable.** All documents must be in English and show amounts in U.S Dollars.*
5. *Documentation of insurance must declare adequate health and life coverage (which must include medical repatriation and medical evacuation expenses) and it must be maintained during all terms of enrollment with Wallace State Community College.*

International Transfer Students

Any international student who has attended an accredited college or university in the United States may be considered for admission as a transfer student. Transfer students must also submit the following:

- a. *Official transcripts from all previously attended United States colleges and universities mailed directly to Wallace State Community College Office of International Students.*
- b. *Completed transfer eligibility form or letter from the most recently attended college or university that clearly states the student is **"IN GOOD STANDING" AND "IN-STATUS"**.*

All documents required for admission as a first-time college student or transfer student must be on file before an admissions decision will be made. An I-20 will only be issued to applicants who meet all criteria and are IN-STATUS with the Immigration and Naturalization Services.
