

Lion Fest Singing Contest

This is a singing competition

This contest is designed for solo acts and only amateur singers are allowed in the competition. During the preliminary round all songs will be sung a cappella—no karaoke machine or recorded music will be allowed in the preliminary round. Contestants must memorize the songs they will be performing. Songs performed must be appropriate for family entertainment.

Wallace State Community College (WSCC) and the judges reserve the right to limit the number of entries in any category and to disqualify any contestant whose performance, dress attire or song do not meet family entertainment standards.

If chosen to proceed to the final round, contestants will be allowed the use of recorded music or one instrument for the final performance. Maximum performing time is four minutes per act and time limits will be strictly enforced.

All participants and their families release WSCC from any liability resulting from their performance and attendance at this event. All participants give WSCC the unrestricted authorization to use their name, photo, voice recording, video recording, entry materials or likeness in promotional materials without further compensations.



Who can compete?

Ages 5 and up may participate. There will be three categories for the competition: Category 1 for ages 5 –11; Category 2 for ages 12– 19; and Category 3 for ages 20 and up. Contestants under the age of 14 must have a parent or legal guardian in attendance with them during the preliminary and final rounds. All contestants must be amateur performers.

Prizes will be awarded to the first place winner in each category and will consist of a \$50 cash prize. One overall winner will be selected from the individuals advancing to the final round and this person will receive a \$100 cash prize and the opportunity to perform at Wallace State and other community events.

The Competition and Judging

The contest will have two sections: Preliminaries which begins at 9 am and the Finals which will take place beginning at 11 AM on Saturday, April 4, 2009.

All contestants must report to the WSCC Coliseum by 8:30 am on the day of the contest. The judges will select five competitors from the preliminary round to advance to the finals. The decision of the judges is final.

Prizes will be awarded at the conclusion of the Finals round.

Note: Contestants must sing the songs submitted on the application—substitutions will not be allowed.



Registration



All contestants must submit an entry form and \$10 registration fee (\$15 for late registration). Only one person per application form may perform. There are several ways to enter -

1. Go to www.wallacestate.edu/alumni and complete the entry form and submit your online payment of \$10. Online registrations will be accepted until Tuesday, March 31, 2009
2. Send an e-mail to Karon.welch@wallacestate.edu or call 256-352-8170 and request an entry form—be sure to include you name and complete mailing address. Mail entries must be received by Tuesday, March 31, 2009 and they must be accompanied by a check or credit card payment of \$10 made payable to the WSCC Alumni Association. The mailing address for the entry is Wallace State Community College, Alumni Association, PO Box 2000, Hanceville, AL 35077-2000. Entry forms may also be returned to the Alumni Office located on the 11th floor of the Bailey Building on the WSCC campus.
3. Late registration: Applications on the day of the contest (preliminaries only) will be accepted if there is space available but only between 7:30—8:00 am. Applications should be submitted at the WSCC Coliseum. A \$15 fee is required on the day of the contest for those who have not pre-registered by Tuesday, March 31, 2009.
