

DRIVING DIRECTIONS

The Wallace State College campus is located in the heart of North Alabama. To be exact, it is eight miles south of Cullman, on U.S. Highway 31 within the city limits of Hanceville. Students who commute find it convenient because of its strategic location - 60 miles south of Huntsville, 40 miles south of Decatur, and 45 miles north of Birmingham, off U.S. Interstate 65.

From Birmingham

(45 miles north)

Take I-65 N to Exit 291
Exit right on Highway 91 E
Go approx. 11.6 miles
Exit left on Highway 31
Go approx. 1 mile
Wallace State on left

From Decatur/Huntsville

(40 / 60 miles south)

Take I-65 S to Exit 304
Exit left on Highway 69
Go approx. 3.7 miles
Exit right on Highway 31 S
Go approx. 8 miles
Wallace State on right
