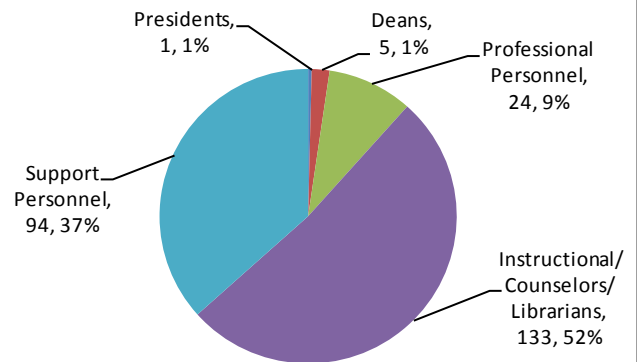

Fall Term Grade Distributions Fall 2006 to Fall 2009



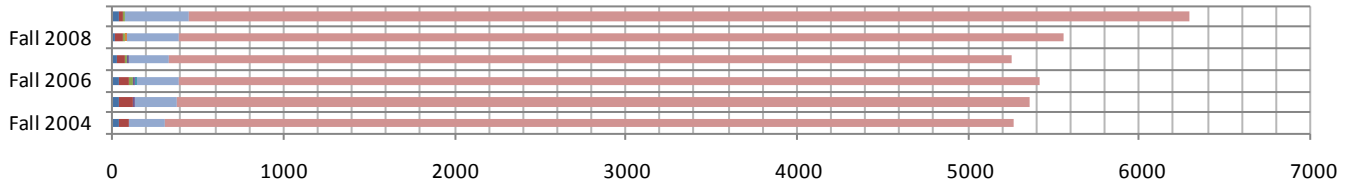

Credit Headcount Enrollment by Site Fall 2004 to Fall 2009

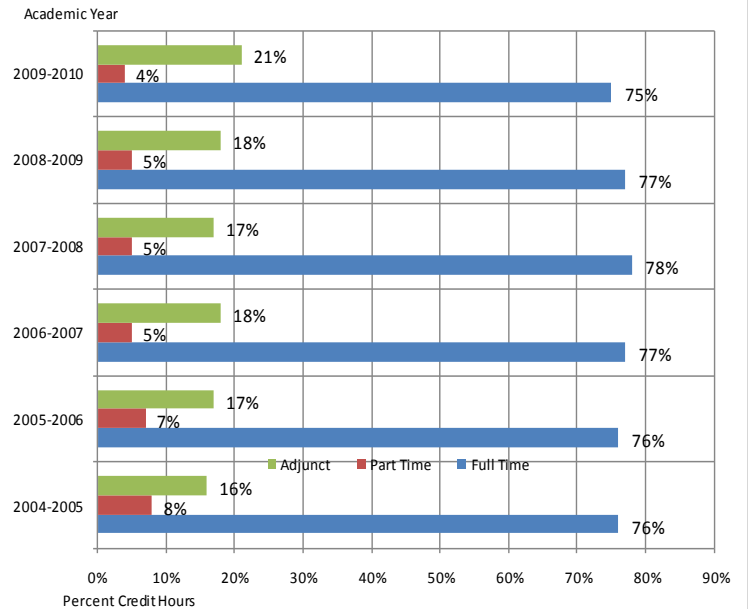

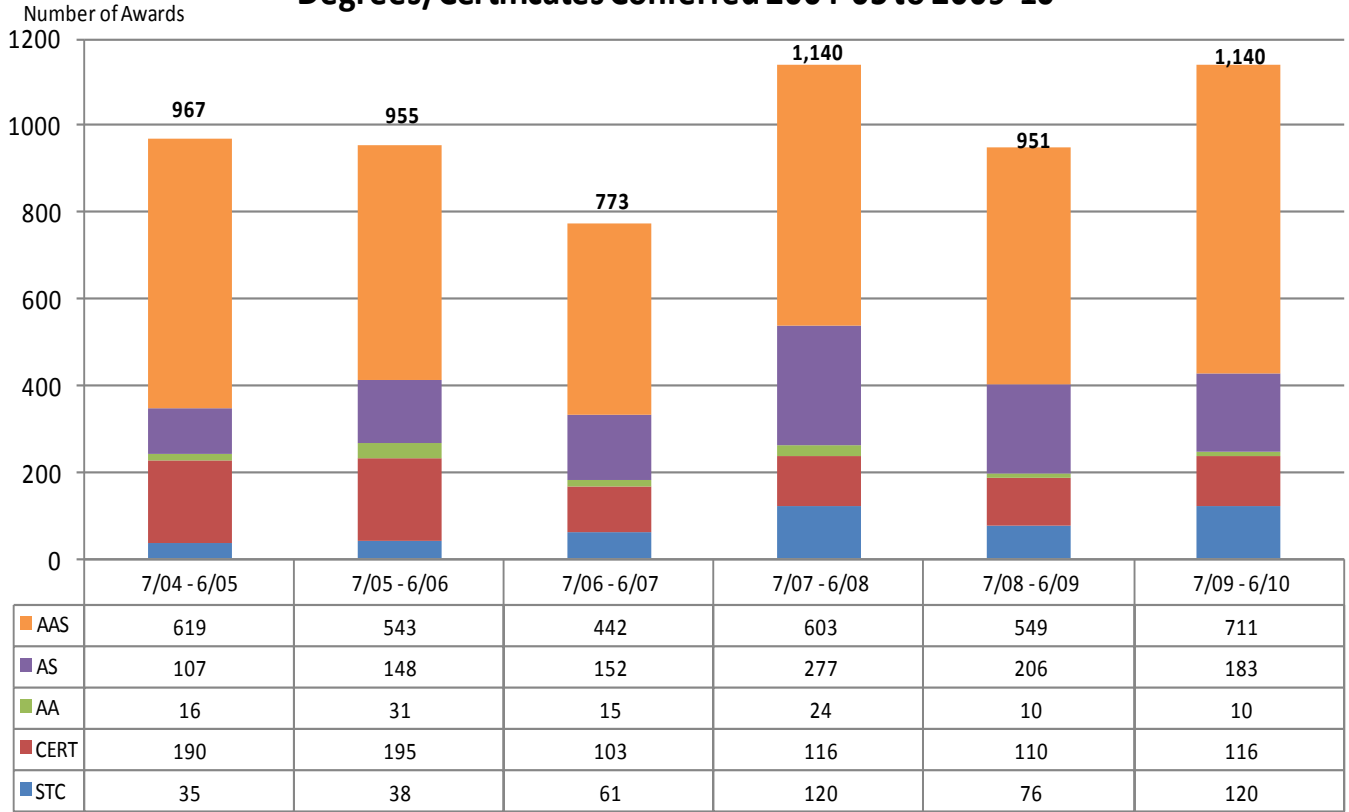
