The JRCERT has defined “not actively seeking employment” for any one of the following reasons:

- 1) Graduate fails to communicate with program officials regarding employment status after multiple attempts
- 2) Graduate is unwilling to seek employment that requires relocation,
- 3) Graduate is unwilling to accept employment due to salary or hours,
- 4) Graduate is on active military duty,
- 5) Graduate is continuing education.

2017	89%	39 admitted/35 completed 4 voluntary withdrawals; 0 academic dismissals
2016	77%	37 admitted/28 completed 3 academic dismissals; 6 voluntary withdrawals
2015	79%	34 admitted/27 completed 2 academic dismissals; 5 voluntary withdrawals
2014	69%	36 admitted/25 completed 5 academic dismissals; 6 voluntary withdrawals
