### General Information:

Fast Track for Industry is a joint partnership between Wallace State and the Cullman County school systems. FTI offers high school juniors and seniors an opportunity to simultaneously enroll in secondary and postsecondary coursework on the campus of Wallace State. The courses meet state requirements for high school graduation while also providing the general education requirements for the certificate and associate degree programs. Students will be enrolled full-time at the high school on the community college campus.

### Admission Requirements:

Student must complete the Fast Track for Industry application and submit it along with all required documents to his/her high school counselor. The school administration will then recommend the student for the program if the student has met all necessary criteria. The counselor will complete the remainder of the application and submit the application along with an official high school recommendation, transcript, and the Graduation Requirements Check List to the Extended Learning Department / Fast Track and Dual Enrollment.

### General entry qualifications will include the following:

- GPA of 2.5 or higher
- Accuplacer Placement Exam or Comparable ACT scores – 18 in English, 20 in math
- Incoming high school junior or senior

### Required Documents:

- Student's Current Official HS Transcript
- Proof of ID
- Placement Test or comparable ACT
- Recommendation from school counselor

### Cost of program:

Tuition for select programs will be paid using WFD funds (Career Technical Dual Enrollment Scholarship). The scholarship pays for **two** classes each semester up to a maximum of 6 college credit hours as long as funds are available. Students may be responsible for costs associated with books, materials, and supplies needed for these programs. Please note that eligible programs are determined by the State Board of Education and the local workforce development agency and are subject to change. Students who choose to enroll in programs which are not included on this list will be responsible for all tuition, fees, books, materials, and supplies. Wallace State was selected to participate in an experimental pilot program regarding Federal Pell Grants. The experimental pilot program is limited to Alabama public high school students in the WSCC service area. WSCC graduation fee \$30 which is the responsibility of the student.

### Continuous Eligibility:

Students who meet the criteria for initial admission to a Dual Enrollment for Dual Credit program as specified in the ACCS Procedure for Dual Enrollment for Dual Credit for High School Students, Section 2, will remain in continuous eligibility as long as a grade of "C" or better in all attempted college courses is earned. Students who fail to meet this minimum grade requirement or who withdraw from a course will be suspended from the program for a minimum of one term. The one term suspension may not be served during the summer term. The student may not re-enroll until the suspension has been served. For re-entry, the student must reapply to the program and must meet the minimum (unweighted) grade point average of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale. Students re-entering Fast Track will be responsible for cost for tuition, fees, books, materials, and supplies.

#### How to Complete WSCC Online Admissions Application

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- 1) Go to [www.wallacestate.edu](http://www.wallacestate.edu).
- 2) Hover over **Admissions** at the top of the page.
- 3) Select **Apply Online** from the choices that drop down.
- 4) Click on **MyWallaceState** listed under #1.
- 5) Click on **MyWallaceState** again.
- 6) Click **Application for Admission** which is the second box in the choice listed.
- 7) Select the **First time user account creation** which is in blue under the **Login** button and read the instructions.
- 8) Create a Login ID and PIN (DE students – we suggest using the first four letters of your last name and the last four numbers of your social security for your Login ID and your six-digit date of birth for your PIN).
- 9) **Select Dual Enrollment** in the drop down for Application Type.
- 10) Select the term in which you plan to begin taking courses (i.e. Fall 2020).
- 11) A check list will come up – please complete each item on this checklist.
- 12) **Select Program of Study** – when you come to the Program of Study on the checklist, it indicates to select High School Student which is not an option. **Dual Enrollment or Fast Track Academy student should choose General Studies. Career Technical or Fast Track for Industry student should choose major for the program in which you plan to begin (i.e. – WDT for Welding).**
- 13) **Select High School Code** from search and drop down – on the high school checklist. If your high school/cover school is not listed select Homeschool. **Make sure to include your high school graduation date.** You can use May 1<sup>st</sup> of the year you will graduate but please make sure the graduation year is correct.
- 14) Once each checklist item is complete, a blue checkmark will appear beside that item. Once all items are checked, select **Application is Complete**.
- 15) Select **I agree to the terms** and click **Submit**.
- 16) Print the signature page and complete the residency form included in this packet. Submit the Residency form with your application packet to the high school guidance counselor.
- 17) Please submit a copy of your driver's license with your application packet to the high school guidance counselor.
- 18) In order to waive the ACCUPLACER placement exam, please provide applicable ACT test score (i.e. 18 or higher in the English section and 20 or higher in the math sections). You must have placement or comparable ACT scores if you plan to take college level English or math, plan to participate in the Pell Grant Experiment, or before entering the 12<sup>th</sup> grade.
