meet this minimum grade requirement or who withdraw from a course will be suspended from the program for a minimum of
one term. The one term suspension may not be served during the summer term. Students will not be eligible for re-enrollment to
the Dual 2 Degree program; however, the student may re-enroll as a dual enrollment student after one term suspension has bee
served. The student must apply for dual enrollment and meet the minimum requirements. Students re-entering as dual enrollment will be responsible for repeated courses, cost of tuition, fees, books, materials, and supplies. (initial)
