

ALABAMA NATIONAL GUARD EDUCATIONAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (ANGEAP)

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Alabama National Guard Educational Assistance Program is a state student assistance program established by the Legislature of the State of Alabama and is designed to provide financial assistance to Alabama National Guard members who are residents of the State of Alabama and are enrolled in a certificate or degree programs at accredited postsecondary institutions of higher learning located within the State of Alabama.

STUDENT ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible for an Alabama National Guard Educational Assistance Program award the student must:

- 1) Be at least 17 years of age; and
- 2) Be an Alabama resident; and
- 3) Be an active member in good standing with the Alabama National Guard; and
- 4) Be an active member of a federally recognized unit of the Alabama National Guard; and
- 5) Have completed basic training; and
- 6) He enrolled in a certificate or degree program at an accredited college, university, community college or technical college within the State of Alabama; and
- 7) Maintain a cumulative 2.00 GPA Undergraduate; 3.00 GPA Graduate at end of each semester; and
- 8) **Must have the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) on file.**
