	TERMS OF SCHOLARSHIP
11.	Student must be a resident of the State of Alabama. To meet scholarship criteria the student may only be awarded if they have U.S. citizenship, including naturalized citizenship, U.S. permanent residency status, U.S. resident alien status and U.S. alien status. Students must also complete a FAFSA form for the school year for the term that they have registered for the class. Any student meeting institutional admission requirements and who is 60 years of age or older is eligible for the Senior Adult Scholarship Program. Admission application to Wallace State Community College must be completed before student is eligible to receive the scholarship. To be eligible for the Senior Adult Scholarship, all application requirements must be met. All transcripts must be received by the college (including high school and all college transcripts). The scholarship covers college – credit courses leading to an associate degree, diploma, or certificate. Repeat courses will not be paid by the scholarship. Continuing Education courses will not be paid by the scholarship. Audit classes will not be paid by the scholarship. The Senior Adult Tuition Scholarship pays tuition only, not fees. The student is responsible for all fees and books required for the class.
