Theatre Audition Requirements

Acting: Student will have prepared and perform a two minute monologue and be prepared for a cold reading.

Musical Theatre: Student will have prepared:

32 measures of a song from musical theatre with a CD accompaniment track. A two-minute monologue and be prepared for a cold reading.

Technical Theatre: Student will have prepared:

A resume of their work to be discussed in an interview with the Director. All applicants will write a one-page essay addressing the following: What is your experience in theatre? How can you contribute to the Wallace State Theatre program? How will you benefit from a theatre scholarship?

Scholarship Requirements

Students are to be a full-time student (12 or more credit hours) each semester. Students must enroll in Theatre Workshop each semester and take Acting I and II while enrolled at Wallace State.

Students must participate in all Wallace State Theatre productions. Student must maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.5.
