Sigma Kappa Delta National English Honor Society 2020-2021 Scholarship Application

The Sigma Kappa Delta Scholarship is a one year, nonrenewable scholarship of \$1,100 valid for the academic year immediately following its presentation. Only students currently enrolled at WSCC are eligible for this award. The award cannot be stacked with other WSCC institutional scholarships. Selection of the recipient of this award will be based on the following:

- 1) Must be an active member of Sigma Kappa Delta at Wallace State Community College
- 2) 3.3 or higher GPA
- 3) Two letters of recommendation (one must be from a WSCC faculty member)
- 4) Completed and signed application
- 5) Copy of transcripts from WSCC
- 6) Document involvement in school and community clubs, societies, community service organizations/volunteer work.
- 7) Submission of a 500 (or fewer) word essay on the essay topic below and a completed scholarship application.
- 8) Please note that this scholarship is to be used only at WSCC.

The essay topic for this year:

• The effects my college education will have in my community in the 21st Century

Essay Guidelines:

- 1) The essay must be on the essay topic mentioned above.
- 2) The essay will be judged on content; however, the essay should be free of any typographical, grammatical or spelling errors.
- 3) The essay should be 500 words or fewer. A word in this case is defined as anything in the body of the essay surrounded by white space.
- 4) The essay is to be typed and double spaced using a 12 pt. font.
- 5) No joint authorship or previously published works.
- 6) Students are limited to one entry.
- 7) Staple pages of the essay together but not to the application forms.
- 8) **DO NOT WRITE YOUR NAME ON THE ESSAY**. Write your WSCC Student Number on the back of each page in the lower left corner. This is an effort to prevent any bias by the panel judging the essays.
- 9) Entries must be received by 4:30 pm on Monday, March 1, 2021 to this year's head advisor (Karen Morris) or the English secretary (Lauren Newman) in Wilson Hall, in order to be considered.
