Mobility Applicant must meet the following criteria:

- Awarded an AAS Degree from a regionally accredited college or university.
- Currently licensed as an Emergency Medical Services-Paramedic, Diagnostic Imaging, Diagnostic Medical Sonographer, Medical Laboratory Technician, Occupational Therapy Assistant, Physical Therapist Assistant, Respiratory Therapist or awarded a certificate and licensed as a Practical Nurse in the State of Alabama.
- It is suggested that non-nursing applicants review information on basic nursing care and may seek Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA) certification.
- It is recommended that applicants have at least six months of direct patient care experience in their field of study prior to application.
- Students will be ineligible to apply for NUR 209 if they have experienced a withdrawal or nonprogression in any previous mobility curriculum including, but not limited to NUR 200, NUR 201 or NUR 209. Students will be eligible to apply to the traditional nursing program. Admission is not guaranteed.
